Our optional level boys - our JDs - had an excellent mock meet at EWA!! It was a great learning experience for the boys and parents + it let me see how they handle the pressure of showing off their new routines. Being that these boys are "optional" level boys their routines are not set in stone. Their routines will change from meet to meet based on skills they learn to add in, ones to take out, deciding what skills are worth it mathematically to have in the routine, and deciding what skills are worth it inspirationally to have in the routine to motivate the boys. So, they are going to have several changes throughout the season. This will affect what the routines are worth known as their "start values." Most of the time for the JD-Division 2 boys their routines will be worth around a 10.6 for every event except vault will be worth an 11.6. Again, these start values will change based on the potentially new and potentially higher valued skills to add in. The JD-Division 1 boys have higher start values. They get additional points added for other things, along with other tougher rules making it more challenging. All of the boys will continue training towards their skill goals that will help them for their Division, possibly moving to Division 1 (if currently a JD2), and for future Levels (8, 9, & 10).
